Am I Eligible?

HELP is available to AEP Ohio customers who are enrolled in a residential electrical rate and live in single-family residences, townhomes or individually metered multi-family dwellings like apartments and condos.

Qualifying customers must also meet one of the following income requirements:

- Household income levels at or below 300% of the federal poverty level*
- Current participation in an approved federal, state or local subsidized housing program:
 - Medicaid
- Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)
- Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP)
- Percentage of Income Payment Plan Plus (PIPP)
- Community Housing Improvement Program (CHIP)
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
